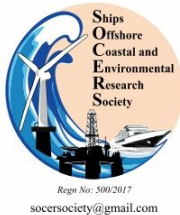

## The Executive Committee

### *Life Member*

Those who received a degree on successful completion of various science, engineering, finance and management courses related to offshore, coastal, naval architecture, ocean and environmental research or professionals working in the above fields.

### *Society members*

Students who have completed at least one year in the above fields shall be eligible to be society members. Society members can become life members on completion of the degree. There will be additional fee of Rs. 8,000.00 while society member becoming life member

### *Honorary members*

Apart from the individual membership, Honorary Membership of the Society can be granted for a period decided by the Executive Committee.

***The membership of the Society shall be granted on submission of application form and payment of membership fee. Both Indian and foreign nationals are eligible. Foreign nationals and institutions shall pay equivalent Indian rupees***
